

VSP Premier Program Student Business Challenge: PATHWAY TO PRIVATE PRACTICE

The Association of Practice Management Educators (APME) and Student Optometric Leadership Network (SOLN), in collaboration with the VSP Vison™ Premier Program, are proud to announce the second inaugural VSP® Premier Program Student Business Challenge.

One optometry student will be awarded one (1) \$10,000 scholarship, plus a travel grant to the annual SOLN Conference. In addition, two (2) runners-up will each be awarded \$5,000 scholarships, plus each will receive a travel grant to the annual 2023 SOLN Conference.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit a business plan that describes your professional and personal plan to private practice ownership:

1. Include a yearly timeline, starting in 2024, with specific personal and professional goals that will culminate with you entering and eventually owning a private practice.
2. Provide a business plan that outlines how you can improve the private practice you've described in your timeline.
 - Include the specific services you plan to offer to your patients.
 - Develop a marketing plan that evaluates location, competition, and promotion.
 - Planning a cold start? Include estimated capital and equipment costs you may incur.

Association of Practice Management Educators (APME) judges will evaluate and select the top three (3) candidates, who will be contacted to present their business plans at the 2023 SOLN Conference.

ELIGIBILITY

You must be an active Private Practice Club board member representative from your school of optometry.

You must be a current student attending one of the 24 schools or colleges of optometry with a SOLN-affiliated Private Practice Club.
